How to Light Up Your Float

Light up your float, trailer, car, truck, bike, tractor, wagon, or even walking participants.

Vehicles & Floats:

- Use a generator to plug in strings of lights, floods, or spot lights. Use clear tape to attach strings of lights.
- Use an inverter for your vehicle battery.
- Use an adapter with the cigarette lighter in your vehicle.
- Use battery operated lights or candles.
- Use reflective surfaces, such as mirrors, aluminum foil, or mylar balloons.
- Use glow in the dark paint.

Walkers

- Wear light up pins, glow necklaces, bracelets and hats.
- Carry light up batons, scepters, and glow sticks.
- Carry battery operated candlesticks.
- Wear light up clothing.
